Course Title: TACTICAL MEDICINE TECHNICIAN (TMT)

Course Description: This 40-hour course meets and exceeds California POST and EMSA guidelines for Tactical Medicine and provides 40 hours of CAPCE (formerly CECBEMS) credits and/or POST CPT for LE officers. It is held at Strategic Operations, Inc. (STOPS) in San Diego; utilizing STOPS Hyper-Realistic® capabilities which can be viewed at www.strategic-operations.com. In addition to passing all the required skills practicums, at the end of the course, each student will undergo the TMT gauntlet and take the written exam for NAEMT TECC certification. Whether certifying as a tactical paramedic on a SWAT team or preparing for Rescue Task Force (RTF) deployment in a Unified Response to Violent Incidents (URVI), this course will imbed the inter-operable core skills you will need to provide under pressure.
